COSTUMING:

Girls:

- black and silver dress (provided) -
- show choir shoes
- silver rhinestone barrette (with hair curled and partially pulled back away from your face)
- nude bra, either strapless or with clear straps
- mascara, eye liner, blush, and red lipstick (we will provide the lipstick)
- **NO** earrings, jewelry, or colored nail polish

Boys:

- black shirt (provided)
- vest (provided)
- bow tie (provided)
- black dress pants -
- black socks
- black shoes
- black belt

*On Competition day:

* Girls should have their hair and make-up done (except for lipstick), be wearing their correct bra, tights, and bring their shoes. They will put on their dresses at Jefferson.

* Boys should already have their black pants, belt, socks, and shoes on. They will put on their shirts, vests, and bow ties at Jefferson.

* We will bring the shirts, vests, and bow ties for boys, and dresses and lipstick for the girls to put on in once we arrive at our homeroom at Jefferson. Please see the costuming list for what you need.

* Because we perform on Friday afternoon, students will be dismissed to begin getting ready at 2:30 (our choir time). They will be dismissed from their classrooms to have a snack (which will be provided) change into their costumes, finish hair, and put on make-up (lipstick will be done at Jefferson). Parents, you are welcome (and encouraged) to come help! Anyone who can help with hair, we would love to have you! 🙂 I suggest that girls come to school with their hair in curlers so that it will be fully curled when it's time to change and we can just do touch-ups. We will be meeting in the $5^{th}/6^{th}/8^{th}$ grade rooms to get ready.

According to Googlemaps, it takes 22 minutes to drive from CLS to Jefferson. Plan to leave CLS with your child at 4:15 so you have time to travel, park, and get checked in to meet in our homeroom at 4:45.
